About Urine Tests at Medical Institutions

If, at the time of your periodic health checkup, it is inconvenient for you to have the required urine test conducted at the University, you can instead have the test done at a medical institution and then submit the results to the Health Administration Office.

If you would like to have a urine test done outside of the University, please contact a local internal medicine clinic to conduct a urine test.

Please note that there is a fee for urine tests at medical institutions.

[Required Urine Test Items] Protein, sugar, and occult blood (if you are getting retested: the specified tests only)
